Facts!

- Preregistration is recommended. Please visit the SCCCC google group website for the link.
- Limited host housing is available on a first come, first serve basis.
- Entry fees are \$13/event, \$34/weekend, non-refundable.
- Race numbers should be right and center for all events.
- In the event of foul weather, the chief referee may choose to neutralize, suspend, or cancel any event.
- Remember to bring your numbers! All riders must have numbers!
- You must also have a USAC license. If you do not, a day license is available for purchase for CAT B through D and High School. CAT A's must have an annual license.
- All riders must wear a US DOT or CPSC approved helmet at all times while on a bike.
- Junior riders must pass a rollout check.
- Registration ends 15 minutes prior to the start of the first road race category, and 15 minutes before each respective category at the other events.
- Proceeds will benefit the Baylor Cycling Club.

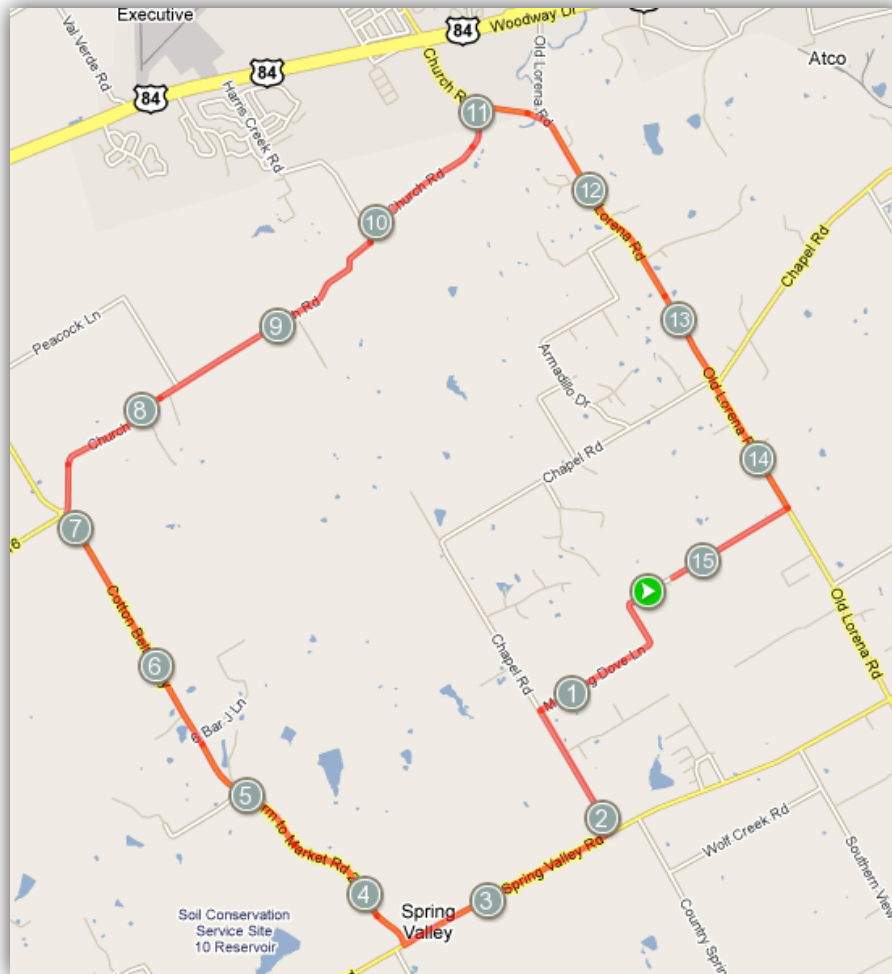

Road Race (Saturday Morning)

This year's road race is a 15.2 mile loop with one 240 ft ascent per lap. It is on a combination of narrow rural roads, and country roads with a shoulder.

Mens A	5	76 miles	8:30 AM
Mens B / Womens A	4	60.8 miles	8:40 AM
Mens C / Womens B / HS Mens A	3	45.6 miles	8:50 AM
Mens D / HS-Mens B / HS Women	2	30.4 miles	9:00 AM

Roads will not be closed to traffic, but there will be law enforcement at two major turns, plenty of signage, and marshals at most intersections. The two more major roads have wide shoulders the whole way, while the other roads are very low traffic. No neutral start, and the course follows a loop so you will need to keep track of your laps. There will be a sign at the 200m mark where the yellow line rule is not in effect for the the remaining distance.

Race Numbers should be worn on the right and center for all events.

Directions To RR

From the North on I-35, exit 323, veer right and follow signs for Old Lorena Rd/FM 2837. From the South on I-35, exit 322 and cross the interstate. Follow signs for Old Lorena Rd/ FM 2837.

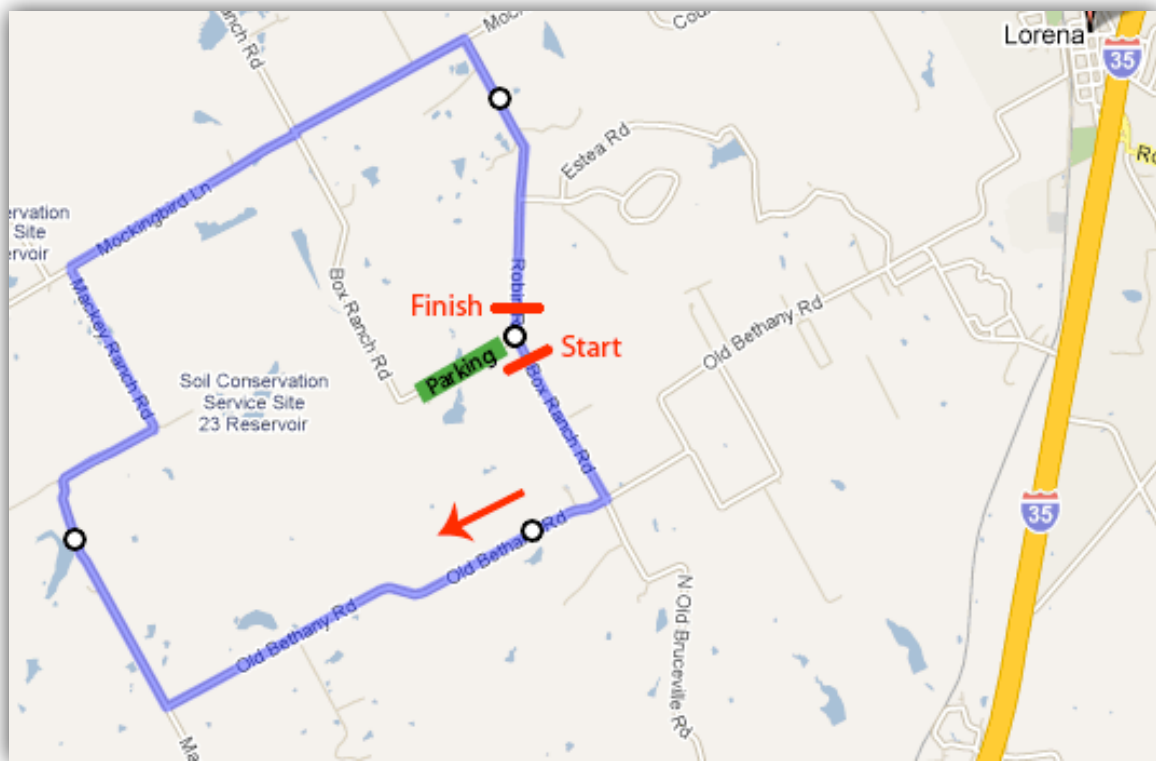
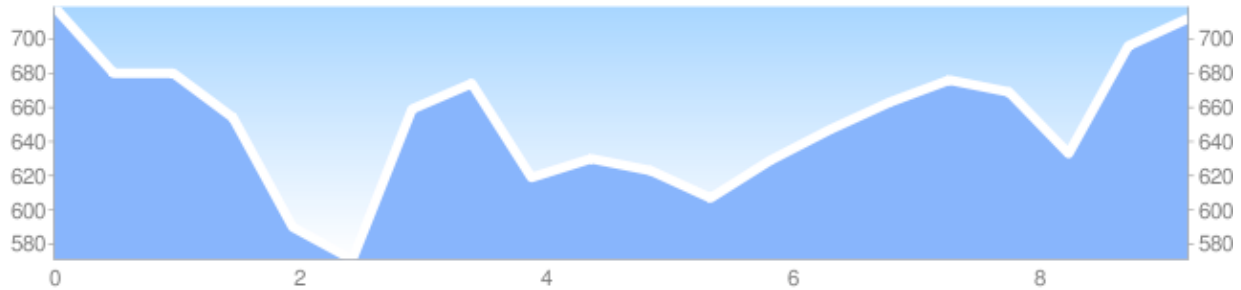
Turn left on Spring Valley Rd, then about 2 miles down turn right on Chapel Rd. If you're arriving late, be careful as you are now on the race course. Continue a mile down, and turn right onto Mourning Dove. We have arranged parking in a field that is at the first 90° turn. The start/finish will be a little past the next curve in the road. If you choose not to park in the field, please be courteous and park as far off the roadway as possible, and do not block any resident's driveway on Mourning Dove Ln.

If the field ends up being muddy that day, we have gained permission to park along the edge of a resident's paved driveway. That address is 2124 Mourning Dove. If this is the case, the start/finish may be moved nearer to the parking.

Time Trial (Saturday Afternoon)

Variation on a road race of old, this course is pretty brutal! 9.3 miles, plenty hilly, and depending on the day, could be really windy too. A few climbs, totaling 260 feet.

Order of start: H.S. Men B, H.S. Women, H.S. Men A, Men D, Men C, Women B, Men B, Women A, Men A. The first rider will start at 3:00 PM and each subsequent rider will be separated by 30 seconds. The official times and list will be posted after the road race results have been processed.

Directions to the TT

From I-35 S / Waco, take the Lorena Exit (322). Continue on the frontage rd for 1.5 miles then turn right onto Old Bethany Rd. In 1.7 miles turn left to stay on Old Bethany Road. Turn right onto Box Ranch Rd and look for Box Ranch Rd to veer left and park along Box Ranch.

Criterion (Sunday Morning)

Unfortunately due to time restrictions at our venue, we will not be able to host High School categories at this crit. This course will be mostly closed to traffic. Plenty of areas to watch the race. The exact course will be announced closer to the event. We may even keep it a secret entirely, not sure :)

Directions to the Crit

From either direction on I-35, take the Downtown Waco/4th-5th St exit. Head west on 4th st towards downtown Waco (look for the tall ALICO building). Continue past Austin Ave, and turn into the parking lot on your left. The start/finish area is a block away on 3rd street. Please don't park in the large parking lot between 3rd and 4th - you'll be blocked in as soon as the races start.

Other Stuff

The road race and time trial aren't too far from one another, so if you don't want to travel all the way back into Waco to eat, you can hit up nearby towns of McGregor or Hewitt. Either one can be accessed by traveling north on Old Lorena Rd to HWY 84. Turn right for Hewitt, exit at Hewitt/Estates Drive and go right. Many places down the road. Or, at 84, turn left for McGregor and food establishments will be on 84 in town.

Port-o-Johns will be at events where restroom facilities cannot be arranged. If you don't see a big green can, ask someone where we found a real restroom.

Most hotels in Waco are within a few miles of Baylor. You can find some cheeeep stuff in Waco, but beware. Avoid the hotels north of the river. The Clarion tends to be affordable and convenient and is close to the crit . We will have limited host housing available, and will be assigned first-come, first-serve style. We ask that you pay a small amount to your host for use of their facilities and any food you raided from their pantry in the middle of the night. Contact the race coordinator for housing availability.

Awards

An awards ceremony will be held at the crit location after the last race is over and all results have been tabulated. Awards will be given to the top 3 omnium racers for each collegiate category.
