Applied for USA Cycling Permit

Saturday Road Race – Rolling 13 mile loop over country roads.

Saturday TT/TTT – Rolling 11.5 mile loop over country roads. Collegiate racers will race a Team Time Trial and High schoolers will race an Individual Time Trial.

*Please keep in mind the rule changes regarding time trials in collegiate races:

1. Collegiate Men's A racers are the only participants allowed to ride time trial bikes in this event, all others must be on "mass-start legal" bikes
2. No aero bars or aero helmets unless you are in the Collegiate Men's A category.

Directions to TT and Road Race -- From UT Campus, take IH-35 north to 290 East. Left on FM 973 in Manor, TX. Right on New Sweden Church Rd. Left on Manda Carlson. Park in the school parking lot near the intersection of Manda Carlson and New Sweden Church Rd.

Sunday Crit – 4 corner rectangle crit on closed roads. Flat and fast! Merch and points primes will be assigned to teams.

Directions To Crit – From UT Campus, take Loop 1 (MoPac) North. Exit Braker Ln. Right on Braker. Right on Burnet. Right into UT's Pickle Research Campus. Park in the first two parking lots on your right.

Registration will be held Saturday morning at the course, as well as Sunday. Registration closes 20 minutes prior to the start of each event.

Entry fees are \$13/event or \$34 for all 3 events for collegiate riders and \$10/event for high school riders
